AMENDMENT No. 2 FOR PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT**

The Permian Basin MPO, a federal, state and locally recognized organization that addresses the region’s transportation planning priorities, will conduct a Public Meeting on Thursday, January 2, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. at the MPO office located at 9601 Wright Dr. Suite 1., Midland, TX. The purpose of this meeting is to receive comments from the public concerning a proposed 2019-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) amendment. The TIP is a short-term list of transportation projects within the four-year defined period.
